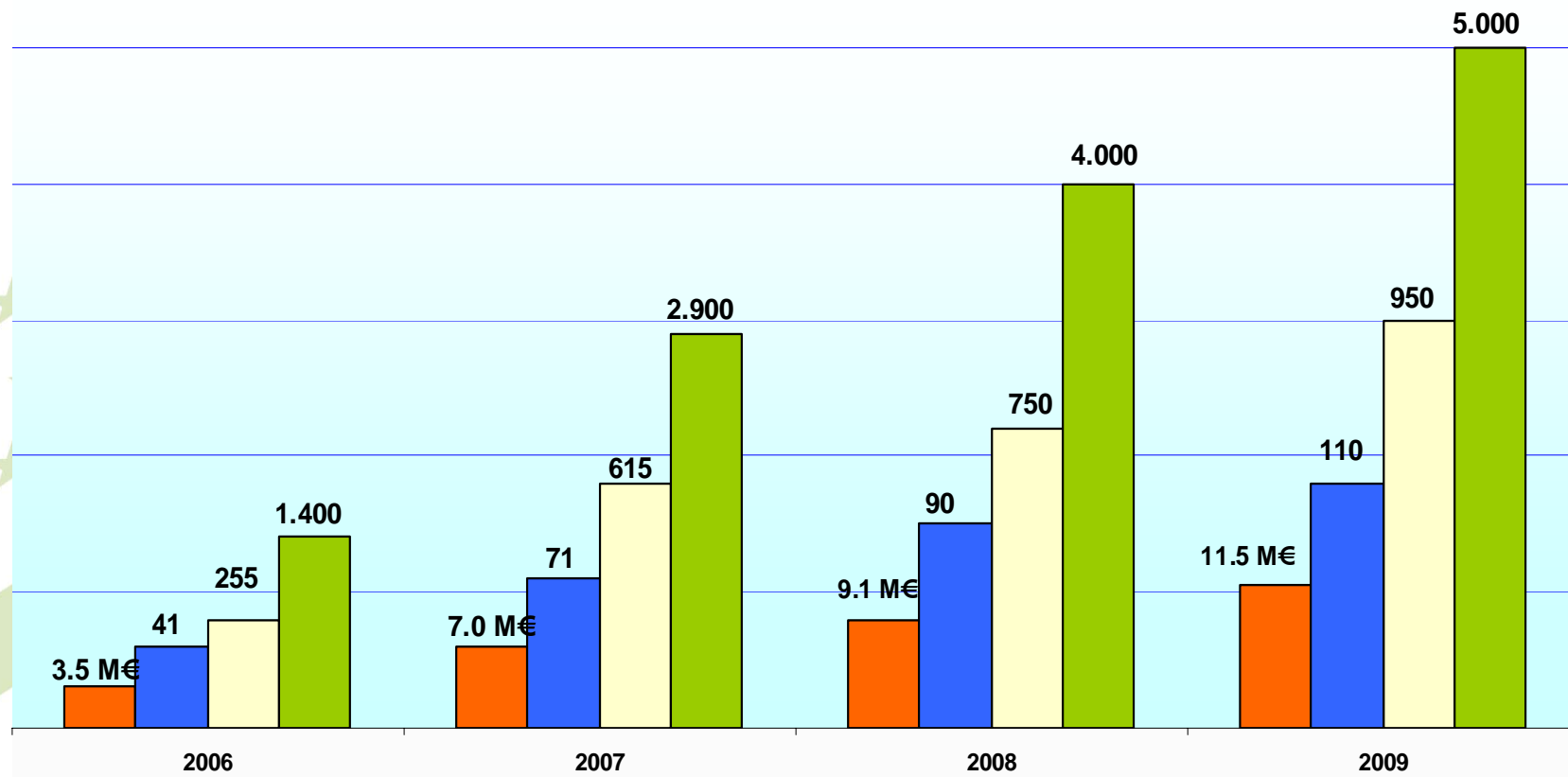

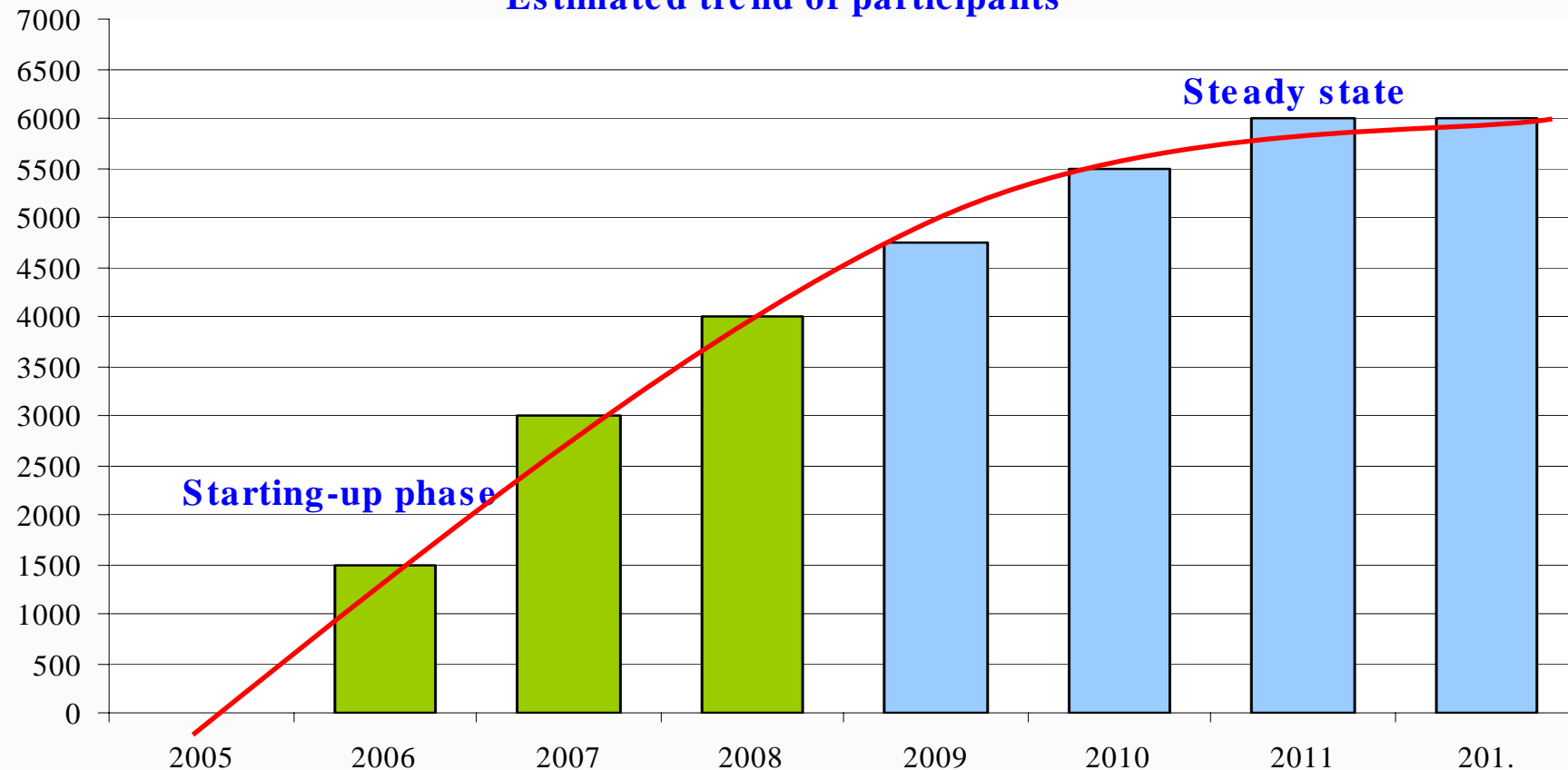
Around 120 events
