What is new?

Grouping lots in to the work packages

The aim of this novelty is to increase the budget available for particular call and to gain on the economy of scale.

Average call it will be around 3 to 4 mio eur



BTSF call 2012

What is new?

Fixed price linked to the participant as Unit price

The aim is to increase the controlling parameters of the operation, to increase the reliability of received data and to decrease the flow of the supporting documentation.



BTSF call 2012

What is new?

Financial offer shall be linked to the price of the trained participant

Requested service from the call shall be financially evaluated and priced as a whole operation, however it must be braked down to the calculating unit.



BTSF call 2012

What is new?

Renewable clause in the contract

Offer will need to include the financial provisions/offer in case of the renewal of the contract.

No negotiations!



BTSF call 2012

How they will be introduced?

All foreseen changes will be introduced in the requests laid down in the technical specification and elaborated as contractual obligation in the attached contract.

What impact will have to the bid?

Change in the bid structure

Change in the financial offers structure

Change in the volume of the technical expertise needed for one call



BTSF call 2012

What impact will have to the bid?

Change of the offered expert team

Change of the managerial structure of the bidder

Change of the volume of the participants per contract, logistics and scale of the operation

Word of caution?

Please, pay close attention to the call text. Do not underestimate the time needed to understand the wording, use the Q and A provision, read carefully the text of the attached contract and supporting documents of the call documentation.

Word of caution?

Please have in mind when making a bid:

Every day is different, thus every BTSF yearly call is different.

Read it carefully to the last word.
